PHILADELPHIA QUALIFIER | RAVEN'S CLAW GOLF CLUB, JULY 20, 2009



Notice to Competitors

- Men will play from the Blue tees.
- Play is a continuous 36-hole qualifier. Your afternoon tee time will be five hours after your morning tee time, starting on hole No. 1. A box lunch will be provided between rounds.
- Play the ball down unless the starter instructs you to play lift, clean and place. Carts are off the path unless weather dictates otherwise.
- Yardage finders are allowed and yardage information may be exchanged.
- USGA rules apply, as well as any local rules on the Raven's Claw scorecard. Note the following:
 - The driving range to the right on hole No. 1 is played as a lateral hazard, not OB.
 - There is a drop area across the stream on hole No. 3.
 - From the tee on hole Nos. 11 and 18, pay particular attention to the direction and yardages to the 150-yard markers. Nos. 11 and 18 are diagonal holes.
 - Play a provisional ball any time you think you might not be able to find your ball. If you then determine that your ball is in a lateral or water hazard, you may proceed under that rule, as if the provisional had not been put into play.
 - If you are uncertain about a situation, apprise your playing partners, play a second ball, and consult the Raven's Claw pro shop at the end of your round for a ruling. Do not use a cell phone to call for a ruling from the pro shop.
 - Keep pace and play ready golf. Pace is more important than honors. Unless your wife is in labor, switch off your cell phone and enjoy the day.
 - Sign and attest your scorecards at the finish of your round and return it to the pro shop or scoring area.
 - In case a tie cannot be settled by a playoff (darkness, weather, etc.), your second round will be the prevailing round. If the second round, 18-hole score fails to break a tie, it will be broken by using the scores of the last nine holes and, if need be, continuing to the last six, and then last three.
 - The top five net qualifiers earn berths on the *GolfStyles* Philadelphia/New Jersey team, followed by the next five top gross finishers. The Cup matches are Sept. 11-12 at Bulle Rock.
